Discipline & Behavior Policy

The St. Michaels Community Center is committed to maintaining a safe environment and permitting all children to learn, grow, and enjoy their experience, with the following policy regarding disruptive, inappropriate, or dangerous behavior in students participating in SMCC's programs.

Students will receive two warnings concerning unsafe or disruptive behavior. The third occurrence will require the student be removed from the program and given a time-out in the director's office. The director will discuss with the student the necessary behavioral changes and ways to implement them.

1. If the above procedure does not result in improved behavior, the parent/guardian will be contacted.
2. If no improvements are made, the student will be required to withdraw from the program. No tuition refunds will be given.
