2. If there is still no improvement, the student will be required to withdraw from the program. No tuition refunds will be given.

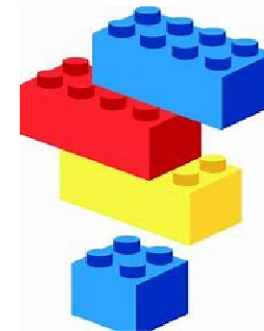
