ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES			
Ability to perform a physically demanding job, loading and unloading, at times with no helpers.			
As a sanitation truck driver, your job is to drive a large vehicle and collect trash, recycling, or yard waste from cans and dumpsters on a set route. You then take the load to a landfill or recycling center.			
Aside from driving through your route, you may need to perform a daily pre-trip inspection of your vehicle, do preventative maintenance, regularly clean the inside and outside of the vehicle. On all routes, you will need to carry garbage out by hand and ensure bags are tie, and report unusual sanitation problems.			
Fulfilling the duties and responsibilities of this job requires an understanding of safe working practices and the ability to drive large vehicles through narrow areas, so attention to detail is essential. Helpful skills include the ability to work in a team, a willingness to work in almost any weather conditions, and a thorough understanding of all potential hazards, safety rules, and applicable regulations.			
QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS			
The primary qualifications you need as a garbage truck driver include a Driver’s license or commercial driver's license that allows you to operate heavy vehicles, the physical fitness to lift up to 50 pounds, and experience with mechanical work and vehicle maintenance.
